Part 5: Homelessness Events Data

- 1) The data are restricted from general dissemination. Users interested in obtaining these data must complete a Restricted Data Use Agreement form and specify the reasons for the request. - 2) Part 5 contains the NYSIDALIAS “ABT GENERATED NYS CRIMINAL RECORD IDENTIFIER” variable, which can be used to link Part 5 to other data parts in this data collection. Additionally, ICPSR created the CASEID “CASE IDENTIFIER CREATED BY ICPSR” variable, which is a unique identifier for each line (i.e. record) in that data file. The datasets cannot be linked using the CASEID variable.
