Data Source:: Published annual reports of administrative court offices and unpublished statistics provided by state administrative offices of the court and clerks of state appellate courts.

Characteristics of Data Collection Situation:

Information for the CSP's national caseload databases comes from published and unpublished sources supplied by state court administrators and appellate court clerks. Published data are typically taken from official state court annual reports and Web sites, so they take many forms and vary greatly in detail. Data from published sources are often supplemented by unpublished data received from the state courts in many formats, including internal management memoranda and computer-generated output. States also report and verify data electronically through spreadsheet templates provided by the Court Statistics Project.

The CSP data collection effort to build a comprehensive statistical profile of the work of state appellate and trial courts nationally is underway throughout the year. Extensive telephone contacts and follow-up correspondence are used to collect missing data, confirm the accuracy of available data, and determine the legal jurisdiction of each court. Information is also collected on the number of judges per court or court system (from annual reports, offices of state court administrators, and appellate court clerks), the state populations (based on United States Bureau of the Census revised estimates), and special characteristics regarding subject matter jurisdiction and court structure.

Notes

1. Beginning with the 2005 study, the Trial Court Data is contained in 6 separate files: Five Major Categories, Civil Caseloads, Domestic Relations Caseloads, Criminal Caseloads, Juvenile Caseloads, and Traffic Violations Caseloads.

2. Changes in Baseline Data Collection for the Court Statistics Project in Data Year 2003

As a result of the implementation of the State Court Guide to Statistical Reporting (Guide) by the National Center for State Courts' Court Statistics Project (CSP), the state trial court caseload data housed in the Inter-university Consortium for Political and Social Research (ICPSR) from prior to data year 2003 is generally not comparable to data submitted thereafter. The differences and distinctions outlined here are critical to the understanding of the current data collection, and users are strongly cautioned to note and understand the definitions of the new data elements.

The first and most sweeping change brought about by the Guide is the introduction of several new "status categories" that affect all trial court case types. The State Court Model Statistical Dictionary, 1989, upon which previous data collections were based, recommended four status categories: begin pending, filed, disposed, and end pending. The Guide detailed and expanded these four categories to ten, and none of these ten new categories is truly comparable to any of the previous four.

Begin Pending caseloads are now divided into two discrete categories: Begin Pending - Active and Begin Pending - Inactive. This distinction allows courts to separate cases that are actively moving toward a disposition from those that are not, thereby permitting a more accurate and fair calculation of the age of the active pending caseload. These categories reflect the pending caseloads at the beginning of the reporting period.

Cases that were previously reported as filed can now be more accurately reported in one of three new categories: Newly Filed, Reopened, or Reactivated (collectively referred to as Incoming - see below). However, neither newly filed nor incoming is necessarily comparable with the formerly used filed category.

Similarly, cases that were previously reported as disposed can now be reported in one of three new categories: Entry of Judgment, Reopened Disposition, or Placed on Inactive Status (collectively referred to as Outgoing - see below). Again, neither entry of judgment nor outgoing is necessarily comparable to the formerly used disposed category.

End Pending caseloads are also divided into two discrete new categories: End Pending - Active and End Pending - Inactive. This distinction allows courts to separate cases that are actively moving toward a disposition from those that are not, thereby permitting a more accurate and fair calculation of the age of the active pending caseload. These categories are comparable to the begin pending categories but reflect the caseloads at the end of the reporting period.

As neither the CSP, nor most court systems, previously distinguished reopened and reactivated cases from newly filed cases, or reopened dispositions and cases placed on inactive status from entries of judgment, the five case type-specific datasets report only the aggregate categories of Incoming and Outgoing in association with individual case types. This is in an effort to produce some level of comparability with the former categories of Filed and Disposed.

New Case Types

Included in this expansion and revision of the data collected by the CSP was a substantial increase in the number of individual case types recommended for collection by state courts. Additionally, some case types that were previously collected became re-categorized under the Guide (e.g., domestic violence moved from domestic relations to criminal).

Variable Naming Conventions

ICPSR users should note that a variable naming convention is used throughout these datasets. The CSP continues to use a maximum of eight characters for variable names to help with backward compatibility. In the convention, the first four characters denote the case type and the second four indicate the status category. For example, the variable called "JDRGBPAC" refers to the Juvenile delinquency DRUG case type and the Begin Pending-Active status category.

Data Quality Footnotes

Each data element that expresses a court caseload value has associated with it a "quality footnote." These alphabetic codes indicate whether the associated numeric value is complete (denoted by the letter "A"), incomplete or overinclusive, and the extent to which it is incomplete or overinclusive (denoted by letters I, C, O, V, and X [see the data dictionary for definitions of these codes]), or missing (denoted by the letter "Z"). Each Z footnote accompanies a negative value. Negative one (-1) indicates that the court does not have jurisdiction over that particular case type and hence no caseload value is expected. Values of -2, -4, and -5 indicate that the court does have jurisdiction but is unable to report that particular data element because the data are unavailable, the data were not able to be distinguished and were therefore reported in the "other" category, or that the data were collapsed into another case type, respectively.
