Convention Delegate Study, 2000 [United States]

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User Guide

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(1) The N for the original data set was 3,263, but the "list" variable (which list - - 2000 Rep delegates, 2000 Dem delegates, or 1992 respondents - - we got the respondent from) and the "party" variables only had 3,243 observations. These extra 20 observations had no address and were missing on all variables except qnum and v2493 (religious preference, which was open-ended). We don't know where they came from or how they had responses to v2493 if they weren't real respondents. But, we decided to drop them, bringing us to an N of 3,243.

(2) There were 6 values of "qnum" that had 2 observations. These were values 71, 264, 692, 873, 1197, and 1817. It seems that we just double-recorded some people because each of the pairs of observations with the same value of qnum have the same address and the same value on every other variable (as far as I can tell). So, for each of these values of qnum, we dropped one observation, bringing us to an N of 3,237, which is what we have in the clean data set (2000cds.dta).

(3) On the original "party" variable, there were 7 observations not coded as D or R. It turns out that the 1 observation coded "1" on party came from the 2000 Democratic delegate list (on "list") and also is identified as a Democratic delegate on v2244 (delegate classification), and the 6 observations coded as "2" on party came from the 2000 Republican delegate list and also are identified as Republican delegates on v2244. So, we recoded value 1 on party to Democrat and value 2 on party to Republican. (Note that we had to convert "party" from a string variable into a numeric variable first. We also converted "qnum92" into a numerical variable.)

(STEPS 4 AND 5 INVOLVE PROBLEMS IN WHICH V2244 IS INVOLVED. AFTER THE CHANGES IN THOSE STEPS, V2244 WAS

INCONSISTENT WITH OTHER VARIABLES, SO WE CHANGED IT, AND THAT'S EXPLAINED IN STEP 6)

(4) We have a variable called "del2000," identifying who was a 2000 convention delegate. It says that 2,892 respondents were 2000 delegates, but the total N for v2244 (official delegate classification) was only 2,866. Here's the reason for the discrepancy: The variable "list" tells us that there are 1,544 respondents from the 2000 Democratic delegate list and 779 respondents from the 2000 Republican delegate list (these N's are after dropping observations as noted above to get to a total N of 3,237), and if we crosstab list and v2244, we get 569 respondents from the 1992 study who identify themselves as 2000 delegates. The sum of those 3 numbers is 2,892. We should get the same number of observations on v2244, but we only get 2,866 observations. That is because 18 of the folks from the 2000 Democratic list and 8 of the folks from the 2000 Republican list have missing values on v2244.

So, do we assume that we have 2,892 2000 delegates or 2,866? We decided to go with the 2,892 number. These extra 26 people came from the 2000 delegate lists and they wouldn't be in the survey if they weren't convention delegates. For some reason they either didn't answer v2244 or their answers were lost. But, we decided to treat them as delegates.

(5) When we did a crosstab between "party" and v2244, we found that we had 33 people who are coded as Democrats or Republicans on "party" who are identified as opposite party delegates on v2244. They can be broken into 4 groups:

(a) 5 people who came from the 2000 Democratic delegate list (by

the way "party" and "list" line up perfectly for all of the non-panel respondents - values 1 and 2 on "list") who are identified as Republican delegates in v2244.

(b) 18 people from the 2000 Rep. delegate list who are identified as Dem. delegates in v2244.

(c) 3 people from the 1992 respondent list who we have coded (in "party") as Dems who are identified as Rep. delegates in v2244.

(d) 7 people from the 1992 respondent list who we have coded (in "party") as Reps who are identified as Dem. delegates in v2244.

So, that's 8 Democrats in "party" identified as Republican delegates in v2244 and 25 Republicans in party identified as Dem. delegates in v2244. Just for accounting's sake, here are the values of qnum for these 33 people:

We looked at who these 33 people supported as the party's presidential nominee in 1996 and 2000 (v2484 and v2486). It turns out that 6 of the 8 potentially mislabeled Democrats said they supported Clinton in 1996 and Gore in 2000 - i.e. we have not mislabeled them, they are Democrats. And, 22 of the 25 potentially mislabeled Republicans said they supported a Republican candidate in 1996 and 2000 - i.e. they really are

Republicans. So, we kept these 28 people labeled as we have them in "party."

That leaves 5 people (2 Dems and 3 Reps) who we may have mislabeled in "party" (and "list"). One of those was a Democrat who said he/she supported McCain in 2000 but Clinton in 1996 (qnum 511). But, the other 4 all supported candidates from the opposite party of how we have them labeled (the one remaining Dem. supported Bush in 2000 and Buchanan in 1996 (qnum 336); and the 3 Republicans supported Gore in 2000 and Clinton in 1996 (qnum 2230, 2234, and 3145).

We kept them where they were in "party."

(6) Because of these 2 changes, we were left with 59 delegates to the 2000 conventions who either were not placed on v2244 or were misplaced. That includes the 26 people who were delegates but had no classification on v2244 (step 4) and the 33 people who had a discrepancy between their value on "party" and their value on v2244 (all of whom we kept where they were on party - - step 5).

So, we:

(a) Created a variable called v2244_original, which is the original v2244 with an N of only 2,866 and the discrepancies with "party" and "list." That way if you disagree with what we did with v2244, you can go back to the original variable. If you agree with what I did, you'll probably want to drop "v2244_original" before sending the data set to ICPSR.

(b) Created 2 new categories of v2244: one is "dem DK," which includes those people coded as Dems in "party" and coded as 2000

delegates in “del2000” who we don’t know the classifications for, and the other is “rep DK,” which includes those people coded as Reps in “party” and coded as 2000 delegates in “del2000” who we don’t know the classifications for.

(c) I changed the codebook entry for v2244 to reflect this change.

(c) I added the “state” variable that we created based on the addresses we had for respondents. It has an N of only 3,213. We didn’t know the state for 24 respondents.

(d) We added the “reltrad” variable that John Green created based on the open-ended religious preference question. It is coded based on Green’s *The Faith Factor: how religion influences American elections*, 2007. Greenwood Publishing.
