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## ICPSR Processing Notes

1. To protect respondent privacy, certain identifying information is restricted from general dissemination. Users interested in obtaining these data must complete a Restricted Data Use Agreement form and specify the reasons for the request. 2. ICPSR recoded blanks in numeric variables to -9 and labeled them Blank. All declared missing codes other than -9 were assigned by the principal investigators in the original data file.

3. Users should be aware that this data collection may contain undocumented codes. These codes were not labeled by the principal investigator nor were they labeled by ICPSR.

4. Users should note the following differences between the Part 1 (Phase I Data) Restricted and Public files:

- 1) The variable COUNTY and STATE are masked in the Public file
- 2) The variables POPULAT, CCTPOF, CCPPOF, CCPPOI, CCPH, CTCTPOF, CTCPPPOF, CTCPPPOI, CTCPH, LACTPOF, LACPPOF, LACPPOI, and LACPH are collapsed in the Public file
- 3) The variable ID\_NUM was created by ICPSR in the Public file. It replaced the variable ID which exists in the Restricted file.

5. Users should note the following difference between the Part 2 (Phase II Quantitative Data) Restricted and Public files:

- 1) The variables COUNTY and STATE are masked in the Public file
- 2) The variables POPULAT, HELPPO, and HELPOLEP are collapsed in the Public file.
- 3) The variable ID\_NUM was created by ICPSR in the Public file. It replaced the variable ID which exists in the Restricted file.

6. For confidentiality reasons, several variables in Part 1 (Phase I Data) and Part 2 (Phase II Quantitative Data) had specific information masked. This includes information bracketed between "[" and "]". For example, the variable POFOTHER (6 PROTECTION ORDER FILINGS, OTHER) in the Part 1 (Phase I Data) data file includes the text "[CENTER]" which masks identifying data.

7. Because long character variables may cause errors in some versions of certain statistical software packages, ICPSR divided the following long character variable from Part 2 (Phase II Quantitative Data) into two variables:

POFOTHER was divided into:

- POFOTHERA (3. H PROTECTION ORDER FILINGS, OTHER, EXPLAIN - PART 1)
- POFOTHERB (3. H PROTECTION ORDER FILINGS, OTHER, EXPLAIN - PART 2)
