This series was begun in 1998 by the United States Bureau of Justice Statistics and was collected as a component of the Annual Survey of Jails (ASJ). The purpose of this data series was to gather data on all adult and juvenile jail facilities and detention centers in Indian reservations, pueblos, rancherias, and other Native American and Alaska Native communities throughout the United States. The survey provides data on the number of inmates, staffing, and facility characteristics and operations of all confinement facilities operated by tribal authorities or the Bureau of Indian Affairs (BIA), U.S. Department of the Interior.

#### Abstract

The purpose of the Survey of Jails in Indian Country is an enumeration of all known adult and juvenile facilities -- jails, confinement facilities, detention centers, and other correctional facilities operated by tribal authorities or the Bureau of Indian Affairs (BIA), U.S. Department of the Interior. For the purpose of this collection, Indian country includes reservations, pueblos, rancherias, and other Native American and Alaska Native communities throughout the United States.

The survey collects data on the number of adults and juveniles held on the last weekday in June 2011, type of offense, average daily population in June, most crowded day in June, admissions and releases in June, number of inmate deaths and suicide attempts, rated

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capacity, and jail staffing. The addendum collected information on inmate medical and mental health services, suicide prevention, substance dependency programs, domestic violence counseling, sex offender treatment, educational programs, inmate work assignments, and other inmate programs available either on or off facility grounds.

*Characteristics of Data Collection Situation:* The survey was conducted in June 2011. The reference date for the survey is June 30, 2011. For 2011, BJS's roster consisted of 88 facilities. Prior to the survey collection, six facilities were closed, not operating, or out of scope, resulting in a survey universe of 82 facilities. During the survey collection, BJS determined that three additional facilities were holding cells and were out of scope, and 1 facility was added to the list resulting in a final universe of 80 Indian country jails. BJS received responses from all 80 facility administrators. Seventy-five of the 80 facilities surveyed responded to at least a portion of the addendum.
