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## DATA DOCUMENTATION NOTES

- 1) Coding sheets were used to quantify data collected from probation files, court files, and criminal record checks. The coding sheet being distributed by ICPSR in this Data Documentation file generally lists the original question/item followed by the corresponding variable name in parentheses. Users should be aware that there are some minor differences between the information contained in the original coding sheet and the data being distributed as part of this data collection.
- 2) The coding sheet indicates that Question 242 corresponds to the NEWTYPE variable, however Question 242 corresponds to six variables (NEWDV, NEWODV, NEWPROP, NEWPERS, NEWVEHIC, NEWOTHER), each representing a response option in Question 242. Similarly, the coding sheet indicates that Question 303 corresponds to the NEWATYPE variable, however Question 303 corresponds to six variables (NEWADV, NEWAODV, NEWAPROP, NEWAPERS, NEWAVEHC, NEWAOTHR), each representing a response option in Question 303. The data contain the NEWTYPE and NEWATYPE variables, however these variables are coded and labeled differently than in the original coding sheet. ICPSR assigned the value label of “Undocumented code” to the values of -9, 2, and 6 in the NEWTYPE variable and -9 in the NEWATYPE variable since value labels were not provided by the research team for these values.
- 3) The SAMPLE, TEENABUS2, PARENTDV2, ABUSDV, ALCOHOL2, DRUGS2, OUTHOME, ADJUST, and CLOSED variables are included in the data being distributed as part of this data collection but are not listed in the original coding sheet. Conversely, the CODER variable is listed in the coding sheet but is not contained in the data.
- 4) ICPSR renamed the following variables to match the variable names in the original coding sheet provided by the principal investigators.

ICPSR also assigned the variable label of “SPECIFY OTHER” to the DISPOS3 variable based upon information in the coding sheet, repeated the variable name as the variable label for the SAMPLE variable, and assigned the variable label of “ARREST DATE” to the ARESTDAT variable.

- 5) The coding sheet contains three questions in a “Descriptive Text” section, however the qualitative descriptive text data are not available as part of this data collection.
