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Codebook

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ICPSR Processing Notes

1. ICPSR provides the 2008 MHRS data in four data formats: SAS, SPSS, Stata, and column-delimited plain text with a Stata setup and record layout file. ICPSR generated all of these files from the original Stata data file provided by the principal investigator. The missing value denoted by a dot in the SAS, SPSS, and Stata data files is represented as a blank field in the plain text data file.
2. ICPSR compiled this document from materials provided by the principal investigator and materials prepared by ICPSR. The front matter, ICPSR Processing Notes, and the Codebook chapter constitute the materials prepared by ICPSR. The latter includes frequencies and descriptive statistics, including frequencies and descriptive statistics for the variables restricted by ICPSR.
3. Most variable labels in the data file consist of a question number and corresponding question text. Since the maximum length of every variable label in the data file is 80 characters, the question text shown in a label will be truncated if the combined length of the question number and complete question text is more than 80.
4. For reasons of confidentiality, ICPSR restricted the following variables from general dissemination:

- id (label = Randomly generated case ID)
- qni2 (label = I2. (Are you/Is your relationship) of Latino or Hispanic descent?)
- qni29 (label = I29. (Were you/Was your relationship) born in the United States?)
- qni29a (label = i29a. how long have you/has proxy lived in the US?)
- qni29b (label = I29b. (Do you/Does your relationship) speak a language other than English at home)
- qni29c (label = I29c. What is that language?)
- qni3 (label = I3. (Do you/Does your relationship) consider (yourself/himself/herself) white, b)
- qni30 (label = I30. (Are you/is your relationship) a citizen of the United States?)
- qni30a (label = qni30a_rec i30a. in what country were you/was proxy born?)

ICPSR recoded these variables to missing in the public use version of the data on the ICPSR Web site.

A restricted-use version of the data with the restricted variables in their original unmasked form is available from ICPSR. Users interested in obtaining the restricted-use version must complete an Agreement for the Use of Confidential Data, specify the reasons for the request, and obtain IRB approval or notice of exemption for their research.

ICPSR re-sorted the public use version of the data in random order. To that end, ICPSR added a random identification variable named ICPSR_ID to the public- and restricted-use versions of the data. The public-use version is sorted by ICPSR_ID. The restricted-use version is in the original sort order of the data file provided by the principal investigator.

5. The principal investigator also restricted some variables for reasons of confidentiality, as noted below in the Codebook chapter. ICPSR did not receive these restricted variables. Consequently, we cannot supply them to users.

SURVEY INSTRUMENT

Overview of the Massachusetts Health Reform Survey in 2008

The 2008 Massachusetts Health Reform Survey (MHRS) was based on the same basic design as the 2007 MHRS. The sample for the survey was 4,046 in 2008, with 448 uninsured adults. The overall response rate for the survey was 43.8%.

Changes in the instrument and fielding procedures for the survey were minimal across years of the survey to maintain consistency over time. Changes in 2008 included:

- ***Changes to the sample:*** The 2008 survey included the addition of oversamples of adults who were African American or Hispanic and oversamples by geographic regions of the state.
- ***Questions added to the survey:*** Additions to the 2008 survey included questions on:
 - Emergency department use (C3a2)
 - Problems experienced when accessing health care (C3h, C3i)
 - How individuals obtained information about the Commonwealth Health Insurance Connector (F10b, F10c)
 - the Impact of the individual mandate on coverage decisions (I19b1, I19b2, I19b3, I26d)
 - The language spoken in the individual's home (I29b, I29c).
- ***Questions removed from the survey:*** Questions removed from the 2008 survey included questions relating to the individual mandate's impact on individuals (I19b, I19e).
