In an effort to avoid simultaneous submission of similar articles to scientific journals, the User agrees to notify CHAFS upon the submission of any and all manuscripts submitted for publication based on findings from analysis of the Chinese Longitudinal Healthy Longevity Survey (CLHLC) survey data. Notification shall include the title of each manuscript, an abstract for each manuscript, and the name(s) of the journal(s) to which the manuscript(s) will be submitted. Notification shall be directed to the CHAFS point-of-contact specified in section 4 or the CHAFS signatory to this agreement shown in section 12. The User agrees to send a reprint of the manuscript that uses the CLHLS data to the CHAFS point-of-contact specified in section 4 or the CHAFS signatory to this agreement shown in section 12 whenever the manuscripts are published.
- 8. The User agrees that the following credit line and disclaimer will be used on all reports, publications and other materials resulting from use of the data derived from the 1998 and 2002 Chinese healthy longevity surveys:
