STUDY DESCRIPTION

These files were prepared as supplements to the Demographic Yearbook, 1980 and contain time series data on population counts, age, sex, urban/rural residence, marriage, natality and mortality for the years between 1948 and 1978. The files are organized to produce entries for twelve tables, often stratified by ethnicity, urbanicity, and/or sex:

1. Estimates of mid-year population and vital statistics summary
2. Population by sex, urbanicity, and rate of increase for each census:
3. Population by age, sex and urban/rural residence;
4. Selected derived measures of natality;
5. Live births by age of mother and sex of infant;
6. Live-birth rates specific for age of mother;
7. Female population by age, total number of children born alive and total number of children living;
8. Life expectancy by sex and age;
9. Deaths by age and sex;
10. Death rates specific for age and sex;
11. Selected derived measures of marriage and divorce;
12. Population by marital status, age and sex, each census.

Each record contains entries for the cells of a single table for a single year for a reporting country.

There are three files. The first file contains 14,953 records of 191 characters each which present the data from Tables 1, 2, 4, 7, 8, and 11. The second file contains 22,221 records, each with a logical record length of 227 characters, which present the data from Tables 3, 5, 6, 9, 10, and 12. The third file has 1,323 records, each with a record length of 131 characters. Each of these records corresponds to a footnote for one of the tables produced from the other two files. Class IV.
