All functioning general-purpose governmental units compose the universe of this data set. This aggregate data collection includes the name of each governmental unit, total population as of April 1, 1980, per capita income in 1979, July 1, 1982 population estimates, and per capita income estimates for 1981. Information is included for all counties, incorporated places, and functioning minor civil divisions (MCD's) in twenty specified States.

The collection consists of one rectangular file containing 40,517 records and 15 variables. The logical record length is 90 characters.

Summary statistics.

UNIVERSE DESCRIPTION:

All functioning general-purpose governmental units.

SUBJECT MATTER DESCRIPTION:

The file includes the name of each governmental unit; total population (census complete-count) as of April 1, 1980; per capita income in 1979 (census sample); July 1, 1982 population estimates; and per capita income estimates for 1981.

GEOGRAPHIC COVERAGE:

This file, developed for the Office of Revenue Sharing, includes information for all counties, incorporated places, and functioning minor civil divisions (MCD's) in 20 specified States.

TECHNICAL DESCRIPTION:

FILE STRUCTURE:

Rectangular.

FILE SIZE:

One file for the United States with 40,517 records. Record size is 90 characters.

FILE SORT SEQUENCE:

Within each State, county records are presented in county code order. These are followed by MCD's (in 20 specific States) within the county, also in code order. Within each county, all incorporated places follow in place code order. Where incorporated places fall into more than one county, each county portion is identified and totals for these "split" places are presented in place code order at the end of all other records for the State.

**REFERENCE MATERIALS:**

"General Revenue Sharing, 1982 Population Estimates Technical Documentation." The documentation includes this abstract and a record description. One copy accompanies each file order. It is available separately for \$5 from Customer Services.

**RELATED PRINTED REPORTS AND DATA FILES:**

PHC80-3 Summary Characteristics for Governmental and Standard Metropolitan Statistical Areas. This publication series, derived from STF's 1A and 3A (see below) present selected population and housing statistics for States, SMSA's, counties and county equivalents, functioning MCD's (in 20 specified States), and incorporated places. There is one report for each State, the District of Columbia, and Puerto Rico. These reports are available from the U.S. Government Printing Office, Washington, D.C. 20402.

Summary Tape Files (STF's) 1A and 3A. These computer files contain the full range of complete-count (STF 1A) and sample (STF 3A) data from the 1980 census. They contain tabulations of population and housing characteristics for: States, counties, MCD's/CCD's, places, census tracts, block groups, and enumeration districts. These files, available by State, can be ordered from Customer Services.

General Revenue Sharing, 1975-1978 Population Estimates. This file provides summary statistics for 1975 to 1978 for general-purpose governments (counties, incorporated places, and functioning MCD's in 20 specified States) eligible to receive Federal revenue sharing allocations. Population estimates are available for July 1 of each file year and for April 1, 1970 (census complete-count). The file also contains per capita income for 1969 (census sample) and per capita income estimates for all other file years except 1977. The file, contained on one reel, can be ordered from Customer Services.

**FILE AVAILABILITY:**

This file is available on one reel at 6250 bpi or 1600 bpi at a cost of \$140. Technical options are listed on the Customer Services order form.
